Art and Design 1 Critique Protocol

Presenting Group

Step 1- Share your project.

- What are you creating?
- What photos are you using for inspiration?
- What parts of the project are going well that you want to keep/grow?
- Where are you struggling/need ideas?

Step 2- Answer questions

Questions help the other team understand your thinking so they can offer quality feedback.

Step 3- Listen and record ideas

The other team is going to talk about your project. You are not allowed to talk to them during this phase. Just listen and write down the ideas you are hearing.

Step 4- Respond

Tell the other team which feedback is most helpful and how you will use it to finish your project.

Critique Group

Step 1- Listen to the presenting group

Listen to the group share their project. You are not allowed to speak yet. Just gather as much information as you can to understand their thinking.

Step 2- Ask questions

Ask thoughtful questions that help you understand what the team is trying to accomplish. Don't give ideas yet!

- Ask about their vision
- Ask about their struggles
- Ask about materials
- Ask about teamwork

Step 3- Share your ideas for improving their project

It's your turn to talk and the other team has to listen without interrupting. Share your ideas. What needs to be improved? How can they make it better?

Step 4- Listen to their response

Give them your full attention as they tell you what they will do with your feedback.
